Dear Mr. Jones:

Thank you for your letter a few moments ago.

I find it very hard to believe that your office has not already reviewed the 692 e-mail records in question--especially since, as Mr. Davis reported yesterday, attorneys in your office have been analyzing the records (notably, against what Mr. Goldsmith himself acknowledges to be "dubious [legal] authority"). Nevertheless, my client has instructed me to give the City of San Diego one more week to produce the records.

Consequently, **if my client is not provided with access to all 692 responsive e-mail records by 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 8, 2009, my client will immediately file a lawsuit to compel the records' production without further notice to the City.**

As I instructed the Mayor yesterday, please notify Mr. Davis directly that all responsive records are available for inspection. If there are any questions about this letter, however, please direct them to me.
