Reps. Susan Davis and Scott Peters to Hold Press Conference with Local Residents on Preserving Door Delivery of Mail

WHO: Congresswoman Susan Davis; Congressman Scott Peters; Representative from the office of Rep. Juan Vargas; John Beaumont, retired letter carrier; and local residents.

WHAT: Rep. Susan Davis and Rep. Scott Peters will hold a press conference with local residents opposing efforts to end door delivery of mail. **Davis has introduced legislation in the House stressing that door delivery must not end.**

WHY: Postal reform efforts in both the House and Senate call for the elimination of door delivery over the next six years. Instead of getting mail at their door, residents would be forced to pick up their mail at shared cluster boxes, many of which are in unsecure locations, poorly maintained and far from people's homes. Besides inaccessibility, there have been reports of neighborhood cluster boxes being stolen, damaged or vandalized. Residents are ultimately responsible for maintenance and repair of the cluster boxes.
