Subject: FYI - New Subcontractor Listing Requirement at Time of Bid - Effective July 1 -- Agencies Required to Put in Specs or General Conditions

Importance: High

San Diego County Public Agency Representatives:

You may already be aware of this, but effective July 1, 2014, a prime contractor is required to include the license number of a listed subcontractor when submitting a bid on any public work in California. This is in addition to the name and location of the place of business of the subcontractor, which already is required by current law.

AGC has notified its members of [AB 44](#) (link to bill), and some of its provisions. You should note that public agencies are required to put these requirements in bid specifications or in the general conditions under which bids will be received.
