



**CONTINUATION OF COMPLAINT:**

**Esbeidy BALDERAS-Valle**

**PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT**

On May 14, 2018, Border Patrol Agent A. Cundiff and Border Patrol Agent R. Frederick were performing assigned duties in the Boulevard Border Patrol Station's area of responsibility. At approximately 8:30 AM, Agent Frederick observed a group of five individuals walking north from an area known to Border Patrol agents as "Three Sisters." Agent Cundiff responded and observed the group run south. Agent Cundiff ran after the group and located three individuals hiding in some brush. Agent Cundiff identified himself as a United States Border Patrol agent and conducted an immigration inspection. All three individuals, including one later identified as the defendant Esbeidy BALDERAS-Valle, admitted to being citizens of Mexico without any immigration documents that would allow them to legally enter or remain in the United States. At approximately 9:15 AM, Agent Cundiff placed all three individuals, including BALDERAS, under arrest. This area is approximately 23 miles east of the Tecate, California Port of Entry and approximately four miles north of the United States/Mexico International Boundary. During administrative processing, BALDERAS stated that she entered the United States on May 14, 2018.
