DECLARATION OF ANTONIO CRUZ-JIMENEZ

- 1. I am the defendant in the above captioned case.
- 2. I was arrested on Saturday May 19, 2018.
- 3. I was kept at a Border Patrol Station on Saturday night and then transferred to another immigration detention center on Sunday. I am not sure of the names or locations of where I was kept.
- 4. The agents who arrested me did not ask if I took medication or if I needed medical attention.
- 5. I was allowed to wash my hands with soap on Saturday before the agents took my fingerprints. Thereafter there was no soap to wash my hands or body.
- 6. I was not given access to a shower or clean clothes.
- 7. I was not given access to a phone to notify my family of my arrest.
- 8. I was not given a tooth brush or a way to clean my teeth.
- 9. I was not given access to religious services, a counselor, or recreation time outside.
- 10. I was given a mattress pad and a thin aluminum blanket to sleep on each night.
- 11. It was cold. I spelt on the floor. The lights were on the entire time.
- 12. I was kept in the same room as about 15 other detainees each day.
- 13. The agents gave me juice, cookies, and a burrito twice on Saturday and three times on Sunday.

I state under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
