Dear Progressive Allies,

The most important race in San Diego County in 2020 is the District 3 Supervisor race. This is a defining moment for our region as we fight to protect and empower working families made up of immigrants, people of color, women and veterans. We're going door to door, turning out the vote because the safety of our most vulnerable populations has been targeted far too many times by right-wing Republicans.

With the retirement of Supervisor Cox in District 1 and no Republicans in the race, we are assured of having at least two progressives on the five-member Board of Supervisors. That means the swing seat to determine the majority will be District 3, currently held by Trump touting Kristin Gaspar. At every opportunity, Gaspar has furthered Trump's agenda - from voting with Trump against California's sanctuary laws endangering immigrants to supporting tax cuts for the wealthy off the backs of workers.

San Diegans deserve better. Unseating Supervisor Kristin Gaspar will give progressives a majority on the County Board of Supervisors and provide a generational opportunity to change the future of our entire region.

But this task will NOT be easy. Republicans and their anti-worker forces have pledged millions of dollars to ensure a Pro-Trump Republican majority is maintained. And just like Trump, they are not bound by any restrictions against untrue slander and smears. We will have to work tirelessly to win, but mostly we will have to be united.
