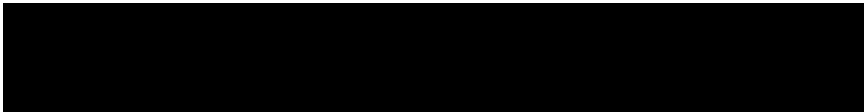

You are requested not to disclose the existence of this letter for an indefinite period of time. Any such disclosure will impede this investigation and thereby interfere with the enforcement of federal law.
