Dear Mr. Conde:

In accordance with California Code of Regulations, Title 5, Section 80303, the following correspondence constitutes notification by *San Diego Unified School District* regarding allegations of misconduct by District Employee, *Bruno Schonian*.

The allegations include that Bruno Schonian agreed to retire from his employment with the District effective March 31, 2020 for unprofessional conduct. His actions included multiple allegations of sexual harassment from Redacted and students. A thorough investigation by our District's Quality Assurance Office noted that there was not sufficient evidence to support claims of Redacted. However, a thorough investigation dated May 2, 2019 conducted by the site principal, provided enough evidence to pursue discipline for grooming a female student.

The District settled an agreement on June 19, 2019 that he would retire from his employment with the District as of March 31, 2020. He will remain on Paid Administrative Leave until his retirement date.
